What is Sustainable Agriculture?

Sustainable agriculture refers to a food and production and distribution system that is environmentally sound, economically viable, and community focused. To support a sustainable food system, purchase from local farms that use practices such as integrated pest management (IPM) to reduce pesticide use, rotational grazing to recycle nutrients into the soil, or other farming practices that work in harmony with nature.

BEILER FAMILY FARM 225 Ross Hill Rd Spring Mills, PA 16875

Rt. 45E go 3.7 miles after crossing Rt. 144 in Centre Hall, turn left onto Ross Hill Road (at Jersey Shore Bank). Farm 1/2 mile on left. Tour this grass-based, family-

operated dairy farm including pastures and cows, chickens and portable chicken coops, milking parlor, and cheese plant. Free samples of food produced on the farm. Pastured poultry, eggs, beef, pork,

cheeses, and other dairy products for sale.

ORGANIC FARM 127 Zuck Road Spring Mills, PA 16875

CG COMMON GROUND

Take Rt. 322E approximately 12 miles from State College to Mountain Back Road, turn right. Take first left onto Zuck Road; stay left to end at farm.

Certified organic farm with vegetables, lamb, hay, and intensive gardens and greenhouse. Follow a treelined wildflower trail through meadows to spectacular views of the valley. Tour the raised beds and trellises for tomatoes, beans, and cucumbers. Try your hand at leading sheep or grooming THT PENN STATE HIGHTUNNEL a horse. Pick your own vegetables and flowers while they last. Children can enjoy digging for potatoes. Vegetables, lamb and wool, along

with ready-to-eat food and beverage for sale. DEMETER'S GARDEN

203 Chestnut Street Spring Mills, PA 16875

Take Rt. 322E to the town of Potters Mills. Take a left onto Rt. 144N, then immediate right on to Chestnut Street (before Eutaw House). Farm is 1/2 mile on left.

Specialty fruit and produce farm with many beehives growing berries, currants, okra and experimental blackeyed peas. Tour black-eyed pea test plots and a new planting of hops learn about issues of growing hops in this area. Jam making demo at 2pm. Depending on crop maturity sample black-eyed peas and okra! Jams, jellies and honey for sale.

FC FULL CIRCLE FARM 132 Goodhart Road

Spring Mills, PA 16875 Take Rt. 322E, approximately 12 miles. Turn left onto Red Mill Road. Go right at first stop sign, then first left onto Goodhart Rd. First farm on the right.

Small, certified organic, diversified family farm featuring small-scale produce, cut flower gardens, cows, heritage turkeys, chickens, sheep, and pigs in a movable pigtractor! Enjoy feeding fish in the pond. Holiday farm-photo cards and micro-greens for sale.

FF FIEDLER FARM 167 Applebutter Rd.

Aaronsburg, PA 16820 Rt. 45E 4 miles past the town of Millheim. Turn left on Fiedler Road (look for garage with Pennzoil sign), 2nd driveway on left.

Small-scale vegetable and grass-fed livestock operation. High tunnel is used for season extension of greens and much of the fieldwork is done with horse power. Farm features a working blacksmith shop, yurt with scenic views, moveable chicken pens, and a full summer kitchen.

GE GOOT ESSA FARM 351 Wise Road Howard, PA 16841

Rt. 64E, 10 miles north of Pleasant Gap. Go 1 mile through the town of Hublersburg. Turn right onto Wise Road. Farm is near base of mountain.

Get a first-hand look at a small dairy with horses, ponies, cows and calves. Watch how cows take "showers" to stay cool. Gift baskets featuring farm cheese, mustards, and fudge, along with whoopee pies, apple butter and jellies for sale.

RESEARCH AND EDUCATION FACILITY

Gate H, Russel E Larson Ag. Center Rt. 45W, Rock Springs, PA

past flashing light in Pine Grove Mills 5 miles to Russell E Larson Ag. Center. Left at Gate H, follow paved drive to first left onto gravel drive.

Take guided tours of the facility including 35 high tunnels (four certified organic) with an array of small fruits, specialty vegetables, culinary herbs, greens, and cut flowers. Observe the layouts of each high tunnel using flat culture, raised beds, and permanent raised beds. Check out the new moveable high tunnel on wheels!

JULIAN WOODS COMMUNITY

215 Julian Woods Lane Julian, PA 16844

Rt. 322W to Alt. Rt. 220N, about 2 miles past town of Julian, turn left onto Julian Woods Lane, follow lane up hill to greenhouses.

Visit this intentional community of 12 homes using alternative wastewater treatment system - where all household wastewater enters greenhouses and is recycled back for toilet and garden water! Greenhouses are used to grow market flowers and vegetables. Tour the greenhouses & water system, observe the laying hens and take a swim in the pond (kids must be accompanied by adult swimmer).

MH MOUNTAINHOME FARM 605 Sengle Lane Julian, PA 16844

Rt. 322W to Alt. Rt. 220N about 8 miles past Julian and Gliderport, turn left on Dix Run Rd (if you get to Unionville, you've gone too far). Go 1/2 mile on Dix Run Rd, turn right onto Sengle Lane, 1 mile to farm.

Nestled in the foothills of the Allegheny Mountains, this secluded 100+ acre blueberry and sheep farm is surrounded by forest and beauty. Sample blueberries and learn about rotational grazing for grass-fed sheep.

MACNEAL ORCHARDS AND SUGAR BUSH 7088 Brush Valley Road

Rebersburg, PA 16872 Travel 45E to Old Fort, left onto 144N.

Right onto Rt. 192E 23 miles, 8 miles past Rebersburg. Pass "Livonia" sign, 1/10 miles past sales shop to lane, on the right across from a church.

Family owned and operated orchard, cider press, and maple sugaring operation. Tour the apple storage and cider press, an orchard, and the sugarhouse and maple woods to learn about maple sugaring. Visit with a backyard flock of chickens, turkeys, and guinea fowl, as well as some bunnies and a Dalmatian dog and her pups. Maple syrup, early apples, and possibly a few peaches for sale.

Rt. 26W (College Ave) to Rt. 45W. Continue MY MT. NITTANY VINEYARD **AND WINERY**

300 Houser Road Centre Hall, PA 16828

Rt. 322E to Boalsburg. Left on Rt. 45E for 1.7 miles to Linden Hall Road, look for blue winery sign. Follow signs (three more turns) to end of Houser Road.

Centre County's only vineyard, with breath-taking views across valley to Tussey Mountain. Property features a 5-acre vineyard growing 7 varieties of grapes and beautiful grounds with picnic tables near fishpond. Sample wine and enjoy a behind the scenes tour of the working winery, which produces over 60,000 bottles of award winning wine annually. Last tour at 4:30pm.

ON OVERTHE MOON FARM 190 View Drive Reberburg, PA 16872

Travel Rt. 192E 2 miles past the town of Rebersburg. Turn left onto View Drive, go to second farm.

Certified organic, grass-based animal farm, including chickens, hens, turkeys, ducks, pigs, and cows. Visit cattle in the pastures, throw treats to happy pigs, hold baby chicks, collect eggs, enjoy a walk through the vegetable garden, and sample prepared farm products. Delicious pastured meats for sale.
